Kew is known internationally as a leader in plant science and conservation and it is a center of research and education, with a staff of over 700. Over the centuries, it has made important contributions to increasing the understanding of the plant kingdom with many resulting benefits for mankind.

Its Millennium Seed Bank is one of the world's largest facilities for storing plants seeds. The seeds may be for food crops or those of rare species to protect biodiversity. Storing seeds guards against catastrophic events like natural disasters, outbreaks of disease or war. Kew continues to explore and collect the world's biodiversity of plants and seeds.
